PLAN!!!

Whether you plan to totally remodel your bedroom, or just "fluff" it a bit, you need to start with a plan. In your planning, be sure to include decisions regarding color, mood, style, furnishings, space planning (or arrangement of furniture), lighting, contrast, texture, and of course budget!

COLOR

Color is always critical, but never is it more important than in your own bedroom ... the master suite...!!

Any time I do a color palette, it is imperative that I find just the right colors to do these three things:

- Nurture if the colors are right, being in the room will be like getting a "gentle hug"
- **Inspire** again, if the colors are right, each time you walk into the room, or wake up in the morning, something inside you will say "yes"!!!
- **Security** colors can help you to feel self-confident enough to be intimate and vulnerable, without fear of attack.

The right neutrals are a must in the Master, since they are the best way to get the "nurture" in. Some of the most "Romantic" rooms I have seen (or done) have been monochromatic and neutral with only small "seasonal" touches of color.

Decide right away if you want the room to be cool, or warm dominated. Note: even if the rest of the house is warm dominated I will often switch the dominance to cool in the master for a more romantic feel.. Be careful, though, not to get any closer than 80%-20%!!
